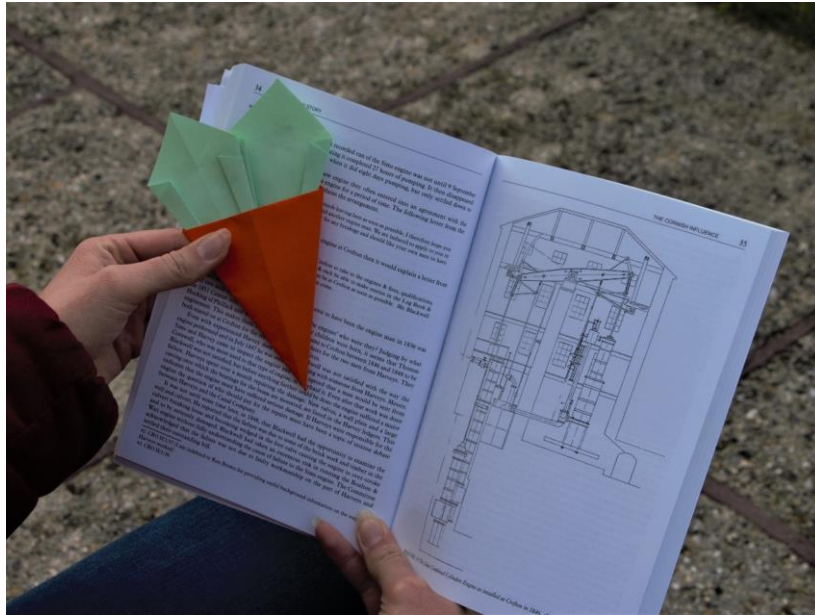




# CARROT BOOKMARKS

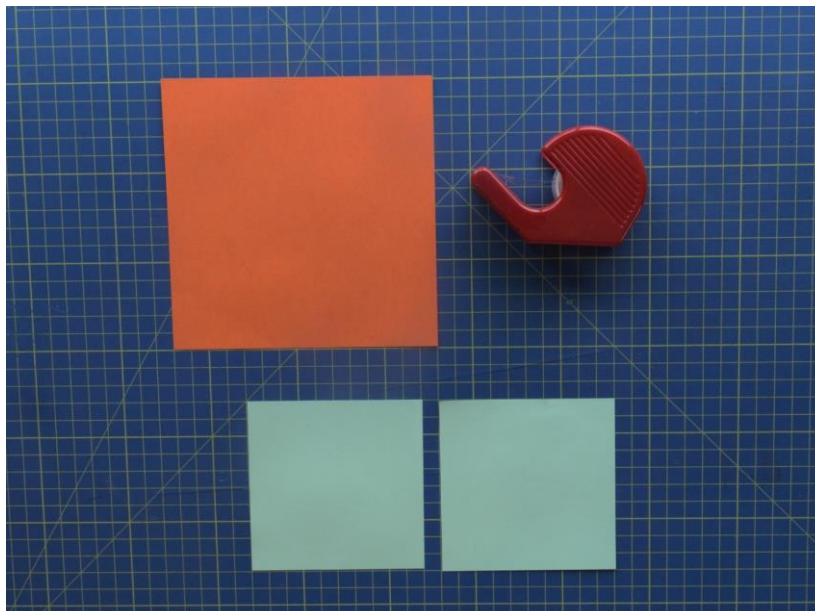


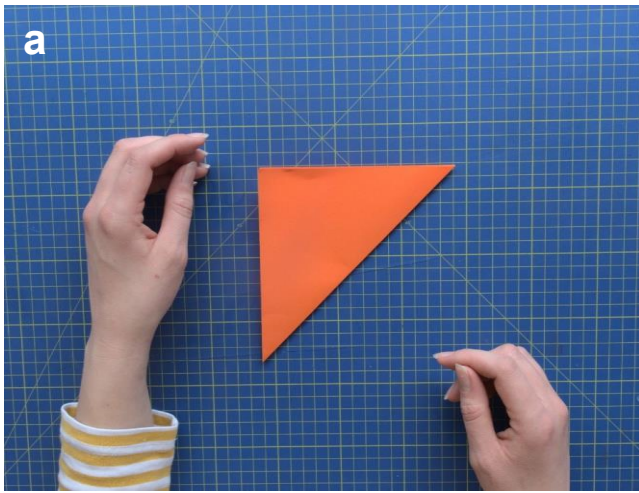
## You Will Need:

Orange paper cut to 15x15 cm (one piece)

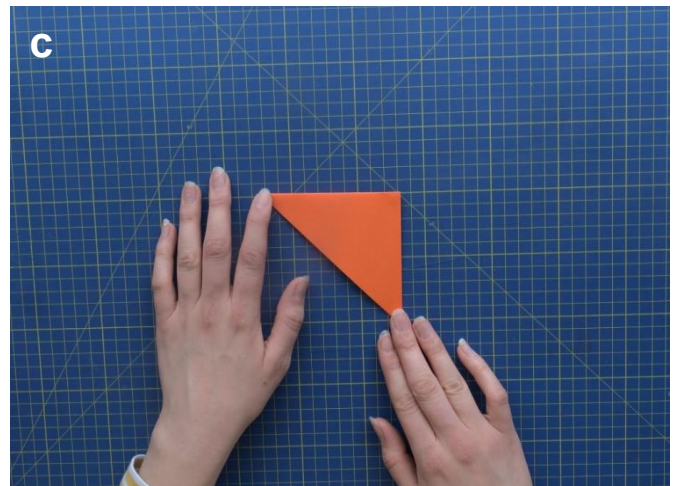
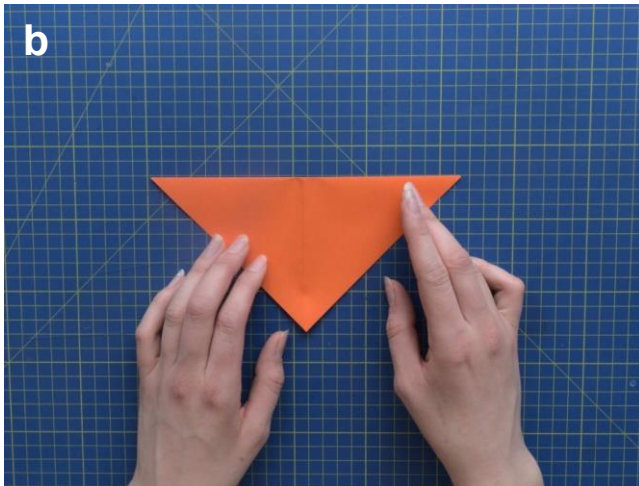
Green paper cut to 10x10cm (two pieces)

Sticky Tape

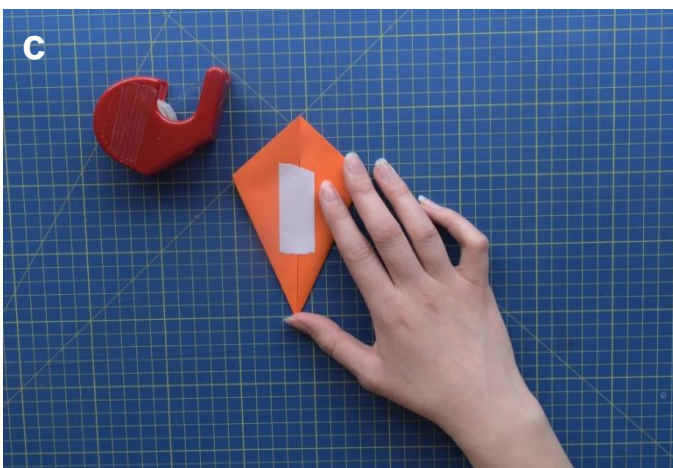
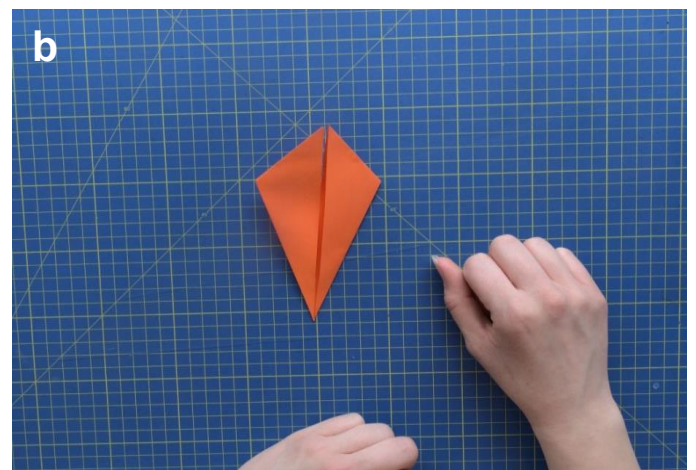
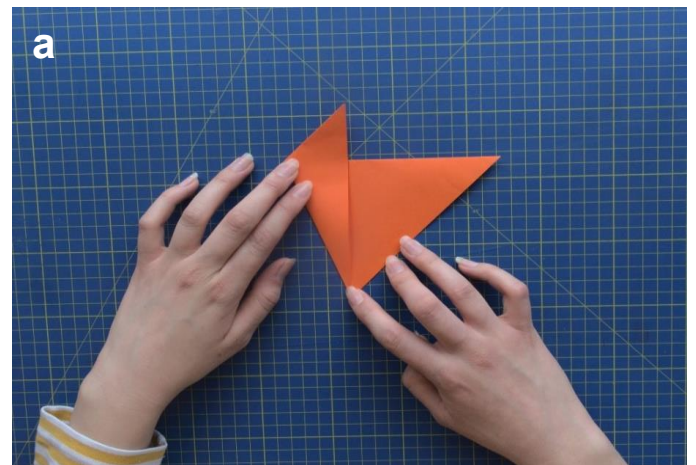




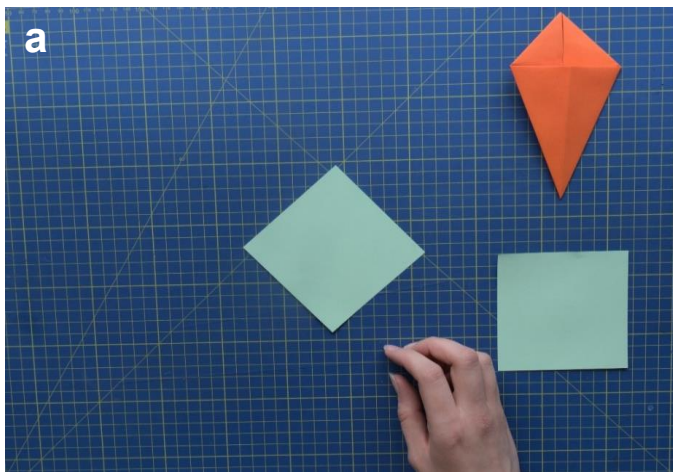
**STEP 1:** Place orange paper squarely in front of you. Fold the paper in half, bottom right corner to upper left to create a triangle. Next rotate the paper so the folded edge is at the top. Fold paper in half, right corner to left, to create a smaller triangle.



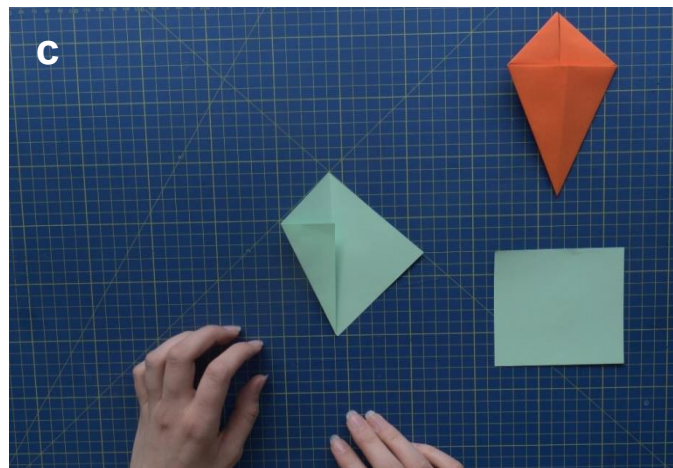
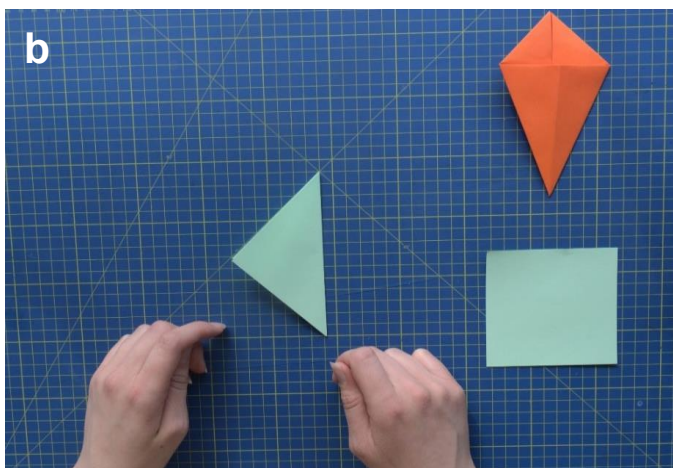
**STEP 2:** Unfold the small triangle. Fold the left side over to line up to the middle crease. Repeat on the right side. Use a piece of sticky tape to secure the folds to each other. After, turnover and set aside.



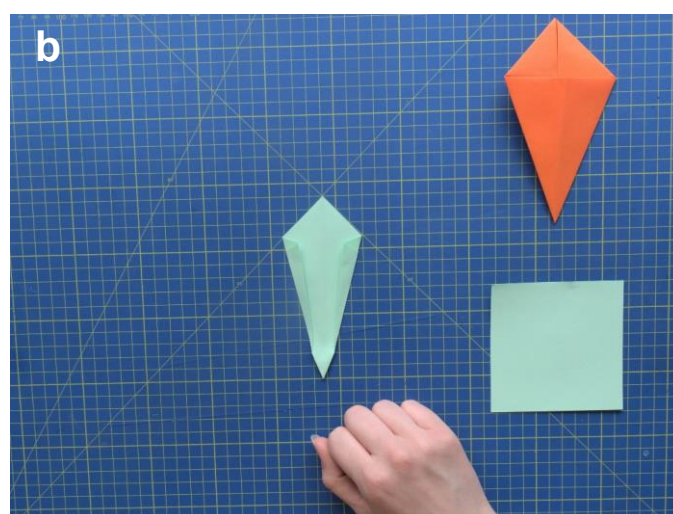
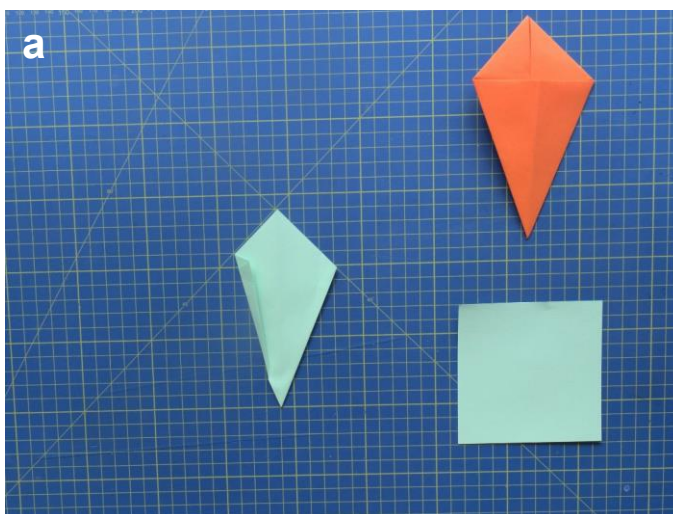




**STEP 3:** Place one piece of green paper in front of you as a diamond (corners left, right, up and down). Fold the paper in half, right corner to left to create a triangle. Unfold the triangle. Fold the left corner over into the middle to line up with the middle crease. Repeat on right side.



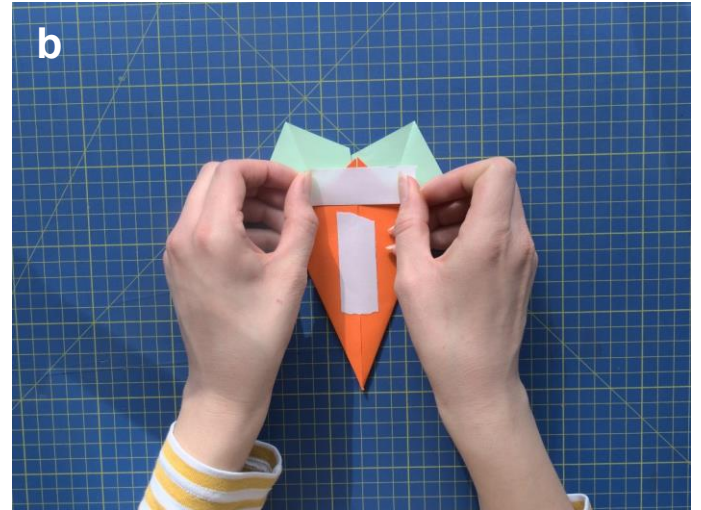
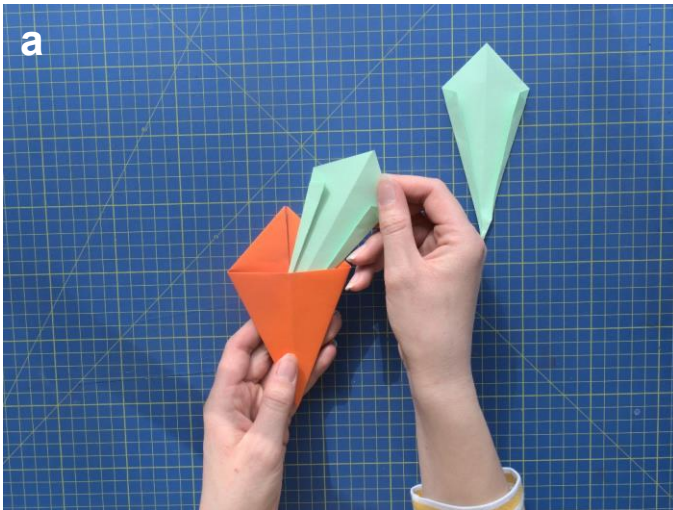
**STEP 4:** Turn the paper over. Fold the left corner towards the centre crease, but not in line with it. Repeat on right side. Set aside and repeat steps with other piece of green paper.





**STEP 5:** Pick up the orange paper section made earlier. Slide the two finished green folded paper shapes into the slit on the front and secure behind with sticky tape.

Finally, turn it over and use your finished bookmark in your favourite book!

**Have a go at making another, but use different colours and textures to make each carrot different. Carrots aren't just orange after all!**
